At the Vero Beach Country Club, the Golf Course Superintendent (GCS) reports directly to the General Manager. The GCS will lead and manage his/her department to ensure superb golfing conditions throughout the golfing season. He/She is responsible for all day-to-day operations of the Club's golf course and landscaping.

Frequent, open, and transparent communication with the General Manager/COO, Golf Professional, and Grounds Chair is required. The GCS is expected to lead the golf course maintenance team as well as provide information, recommendations, and leadership to the GM and Grounds Committee to provide superior golfing conditions.

The GCS is expected to ensure that the golf course is consistently in excellent condition and has a high level of detailing. Continuing education and staying at the forefront of research and technology are necessary for success. In addition, the GCS will provide creative leadership and foster a culture of continuing education and development of future turf professionals. The GCS must have a natural style of "sincere engagement" with members and staff along with a love of the game of golf and a passion for surpassing membership course conditioning expectations.
