DIRECTOR OF AGRONOMY - POSITION OVERVIEW

At the Sawgrass Country Club, the Director of Agronomy (DOA) reports directly to the General Manager/COO. The DOA will lead and manage his/her department to ensure superb golfing conditions throughout the golfing season. He/She is responsible for all day-to-day operations of the Club's golf course and Club grounds.

Frequent, open, and transparent communication with the General Manager/COO, Director of Golf, and Green Committee Chair is required. The DOA is expected to lead the golf course maintenance team as well as provide information, recommendations, and leadership to the GM/COO and Green Committee to provide superior golfing conditions.

The DOA is expected to ensure that the golf course is consistently in excellent condition and has a high level of detailing. Continuing education and staying at the forefront of research and technology are necessary for success. In addition, the DOA will provide creative leadership and foster a culture of continuing education and development of future turf professionals. The DOA must have a natural style of "sincere engagement" with members and staff along with a love of the game of golf and a passion for surpassing membership course conditioning expectations.

The Club is currently working on a 10-year Capital Improvement plan to include a full renovation of all 27 holes expected to occur in the very near future.
