HEAD OF AGRONOMY - POSITION OVERVIEW

At the Pine Tree Golf Course, the Head of Agronomy reports directly to the Green Chairman. The HOA will lead and manage his/her team to ensure superb golfing conditions throughout the golfing season, all while creating a friendly, open atmosphere with team members. He/She is responsible for all day-to-day operations of the Club's golf course.

Frequent, open, and transparent communication with the Green Chairman and Director of Golf is required. The HOA is expected to lead the golf course maintenance team as well as provide information, recommendations, and leadership to the Green Chairman to provide superior golfing conditions.

The HOA is expected to ensure that the golf course is consistently in excellent condition and has a high level of detailing. Continuing education and staying at the forefront of research and technology are necessary for success. In addition, the HOA will provide creative leadership and foster a culture of continuing education and development of future turf professionals. The HOA must have a natural style of "sincere engagement" with members and the Pine Tree team along with a love of the game of golf and a passion for surpassing the members' course conditioning expectations.

INITIAL PRIORITIES OF THE HEAD OF AGRONOMY

- Evaluate the course conditions and develop an action plan for the summer maintenance program
- Inspect all of the bunkers for playability
- Develop a plan to improve the greens in consistency of speed and firmness
- Review soil tests and necessary nutritional inputs to all areas
- Get up to speed on the North Range tee project and specifications
